Hazelwood Ave. Skate Park

The proposed project consists of the design and construction of a skatepark and associated amenities at Hazelwood Park, a presently undeveloped 10.5-acre park site on Hazelwood Avenue across from the Hazelwood Inn in eastern Baltimore County. The County will work with the volunteers of the Baltimore County Skateboard Council to design a concrete skatepark whose central feature will be a concrete skatebowl. In addition to the skatepark, the project will include the construction of a park access road and parking lot, as well as various support amenities. These improvements will help meet a longstanding demand for additional non-modular skateparks.

Belair Road Conditions

EBPCA recently sent a letter to representatives with the State Highway Administration who are applying for a federal RAISE Grant to provide funding for the Route 1 revitalization efforts. Should this grant be approved, it would bring in approximately \$17 million from the federal government for revitalization and safety enhancements for Route 1 from the City line to the beltway, with the rest of the cost being shared by the County and State. This would be in addition to the upcoming resurfacing scheduled for this year.

PROHIBITED ITEMS ARE: (Baltimore County rules, not ours)

Lawn mowers or any gas powered equipment
Explosive or flammable materials, acids, pesticides, chemicals, batteries.
Liquids of any type.
Medical, radioactive waste.
Tanks or drums, unless clean and cut in half.
Animal carcasses.
Wood/logs greater than 8" in diameter and 6 foot in length.
Refrigerators, air conditioners.
Household electronics, including tv's, radios and computer equipment.
Tires, pickup or boat caps.
Brush/yard waste, cardboard or paper.
Asphalt, blacktop, concrete, brick, dirt or rock.
Large items that cannot be lifted manually.
